Creative Viewpoints is an exhibit which will showcase the members' work from the Central Ohio Branch of the National League of American Pen Women.

- **Deadline for Submissions:** Wednesday, February 28, 2024
- **Drop Off:** Thursday April 4- 9am-3:30pm and 6-10PM,
Friday April 5- 9am-3:30pm,
Saturday April 6- 9am-3:30pm
- **Exhibition Dates:** April. 12- May 18, 2024
- **Reception:** Friday, April 12 | 6-8pm
- **Pick Up:** Monday May 20- 9am-3pm and 6:30- 8:30
Tuesday May 21- 9am-3pm
Wednesday May 22- 9am-3pm

Eligibility: Must be a current member of Central Ohio NLAPW or have submitted an application with pending acceptance of the National Office by February 15, 2024.

Members must submit work in which they are qualified for through NLAPW.

Entry Fee: \$20 per participant.

Entries: Members will be allowed 1 piece of work represented in the exhibition- either a solo or a collaboration piece.

Rules: Current members may enter 2D pieces that can be hung on a wall or 3D artworks that can be displayed on a pedestal. Because of limited space, work must not exceed 24" width x 30" height- which includes the frame. Work must be wired correctly with d-rings and wire (see below). Work must also be available to remain in the exhibit for the duration of the exhibition.

Sales: All transactions are done at the Cultural Arts Center. CAC will take a 30% commission of all sales.

Community

Outreach: There will be opportunities for members to speak about their work or do demonstrations/workshops throughout the duration of the exhibition. Look for more information on this coming soon!

***A Note on Collaborations:** Collaborations are encouraged but not mandatory. These allow both artists and musicians/authors to showcase their work. (or even 2 artists together!). Submissions:

2. Email a high resolution .jpg image of your work. Image size should be 300 dpi with a minimum of 1920pixels on longest side. File name should be your last name_title.jpg (example: Smith_EveningLandscape.jpg) and sent to Dawn at artatdawn123@gmail.com. Include your name, title, and dimensions in your email.
3. Send in your payment. Entry fees are \$20 per participant.

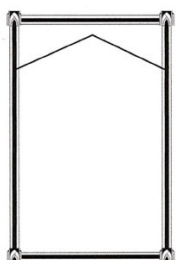

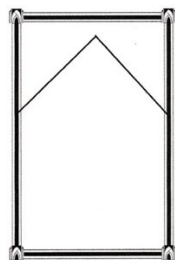
Example of D-rings and Wire for Hanging. No Sawtooth hangers accepted.



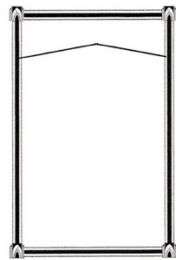
Picture Frame Wiring- Right & Wrong Examples



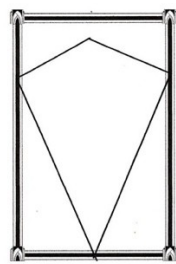
CORRECT !!
 * 20 degree Slope to sides
 * Side fittings 1/4 down from top
 * Hanging wire peak point
 1.5-2.0" from top of frame



WRONG !
 * Wire too low on sides
 * Frame top will lean out
 from wall



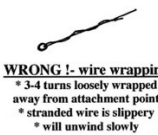
WRONG !
 * Wire too tight (no slope)
 * Tension on side fittings very
 high- can pull out



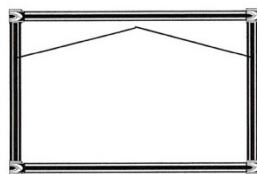
CORRECT ! for Heavy frame
 * fasten single wire loop at bottom *
 takes some weight off sides



Correct- wire wrapping
 * 5-8 turns closely wrapped
 near attachment point



WRONG !- wire wrapping
 * 3-4 turns loosely wrapped
 away from attachment point
 * stranded wire is slippery
 * will unwind slowly



CORRECT !-Horizontal !!
 * 20 degree Slope to sides
 * Side fittings 1/4 down from top
 * Hanging wire peak point
 1.5-2.0" from top of frame
 * If Heavy- use a bottom attachment- as shown on left
